JOHN: The glory of Jesus—Part 5

Sermon: **John 1:35-51**

The glory of Jesus is shown in the calling of His first disciples.

We see:

1. Two disciples of John the Baptist become disciples of Jesus (vv.35-39).
2. One of these disciples, Andrew, *found his own brother* and brought him to Jesus (vv.40-42).
3. Jesus *found Philip* and Philip *found Nathaniel* (vv.43-50).
4. Jesus promises *greater things* in being *the Son of Man* (v.51).

The Westminster Confession of Faith

WCF 8.1 It pleased God, in His eternal purpose, to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus, His only begotten Son, to be the Mediator between God and man;(1) the Prophet,(2) Priest,(3) and King;(4) the Head and Savior of His Church;(5) the Heir of all things;(6) and Judge of the world;(7) unto whom He did from all eternity give a people, to be His seed,(8) and to be by Him in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified.(9)

WCF 8.2 The Son of God, the second person in the Trinity, being very and eternal God, of one substance and equal with the Father, did, when the fullness of time was come, take upon Him man's nature,(1) with all the essential properties and common infirmities thereof, yet without sin;(2) being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the womb of the Virgin Mary, of her substance.(3) So that two whole, perfect, and distinct natures, the Godhead and the manhood, were inseparably joined together in one person, without conversion, composition, or confusion.(4) Which person is very God, and very man, yet one Christ, the only Mediator between God and man.(5)

WCF 8.8 To all those for whom Christ hath purchased redemption, He doth certainly and effectually apply and communicate the same;(1) making intercession for them;(2) and revealing unto them, in and by the Word, the mysteries of salvation;(3) effectually persuading them by His Spirit to believe and obey; and governing their hearts by His Word and Spirit;(4) overcoming all their enemies by His almighty power and wisdom, in such manner and ways as are most consonant to His wonderful and unsearchable dispensation.(5)

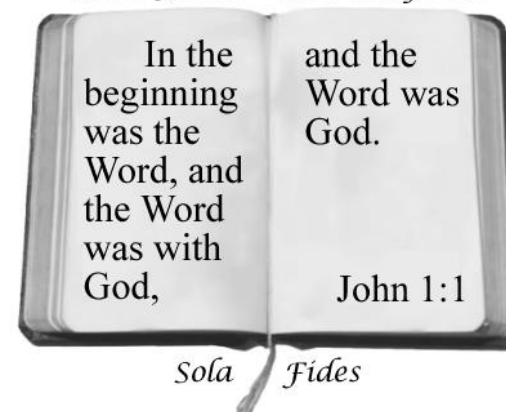

Questions for discussion

[Sermon: John 1:35-51]

1. Why did not John the Baptist find it a loss when two of his disciples turned and followed Jesus (instead)?
2. What is “strange” (different from today) in what Jesus asked the first two who followed Him (v.38)?
3. How should we understand the answer from the 2 first disciples (v.38)?
4. What was the result of being taught by Jesus for *that day*?
5. What glory of Jesus do we see when He first spoke to Simon (v.42)?
6. What glory of Jesus do we see in His first address to Nathaniel (v.47)?
7. (a) What are the *greater things* Jesus spoke of (v.51)?
(b) Who is addressed in seeing these *greater things*?
