I. Isaiah foreshadowed the virgin birth of Jesus (Isaiah 7:14)

Isaiah 7:14 (ESV)

14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His Name Immanuel.

Micah 5:1–2 (ESV)

1 Now muster your troops, O daughter of troops; siege is laid against us; with a rod they strike the judge of Israel on the cheek.

II. The Messiah would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:1-2)

Micah 5:1–2 (ESV)

2 But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me One who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.

III. The Messiah would come from the tribe of Judah (Genesis 49:10)

Genesis 49:10 (ESV)

10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between His feet, until tribute comes to Him; and to Him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

IV. The Messiah would be a descendant of King David (Jeremiah 23:5)

Bible prophecy: Jeremiah 23:5

Jeremiah 23:5 (ESV)

5 “Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and He shall reign as King and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.
