	B.	This Word "Goodwill" Is Used in Connection with Ourin Eph. 1:5-9 ("Good Pleasure")
		1) "Good pleasure" summarizes the reason that God chooses or one person vs another
		2) The phrase "in Christ" repeated here teaches that the entire chain of salvation begins with
