Revelation 22:6-21

I. Intro: Revelation - A letter of encouragement from Christ to his bride, the church

II. Exposition:

- A. This word is trustworthy
 - It originated from God the Father and the Son (v.6,16)
 - It is born witness to by the apostle John (vv.8-9)
 - Therefore it must not be tempered with (vv.18-19)
- B. Jesus' last words to his church
 - 1. I am coming back soon (3x) (vv.7,12, 20)
 - To bless the redeemed (vv.7,14)
 - To judge evildoers (vv.10-12)
 - 2. I am ordering all things according to God's plan (v.13)
 - 3. I've sent my messenger to let you know my future plans (v.16)
 - Signed- your promised Messiah (v.16b)
- C. The church's response
 - Amen! Come Lord Jesus! (vv.17,20)
 - $_{\circ}\,$ Is this the cry of your heart?
- Benediction (22:21; 1:3)
- Four images that we can take away from the book that will help us have right perspective on life and world events
 - Image 1: God is sovereign on His throne (Rev 4)
 - Image 2: Christ is exalted and reigning King (Rev 5)
 - Image 3: Christ, the returning and conquering King of kings (Rev 19:11-21)
 - Image 4: Our eternal glorious state with Christ (Rev 7:9-17; 21 & 22)
