Looking to Our Good Shepherd

John 10:1-30

Intro: Jesus, the Shepherd of our souls

Exposition:

- A. A description of the false shepherds
 - i. They are not called and commissioned by Christ (v.1a)
 - ii. They do not care about the wellbeing of the flock (vv.1b,10, 12-13; Ezek 34:1-10)
 - The sheep will not follow their voice (v.5; 1 John 2:27)

- B. Jesus, our Good Shepherd
 - i. He knows and loves us (v.3,14)
 - ii. He leads us through all of life (v.4)
 - iii. He came to give us abundant life by laying down His life for us (vv.10-11,15-18)
 - iv. He and the Father will preserve us unto glory (vv.27-30)
 - v. He has other sheep that He will bring to the fold (v.16)

- C. The response of the sheep
 - i. We love the Shepherd and desire to follow Him (vv.4, 27)

Application:

- 1. Keep looking to our Good Shepherd
 - He will never fail us (Heb 13:8)
 - He will see us through (Is 40:11)
