

“Nothing Common or Unclean” (Zechariah 14:20–21)

**Big Idea: When God dwells with man, the unholy and the impure will be forever gone.**

I. The Meaning of the Text

- a. When God’s dwelling is with men, everything will be equally holy. (verses 20–21a)

Exodus 28:36–38

- b. When God’s dwelling is with men, no one abominable will be present. (verse 21b)

II. The Application of the Text

- a. Heed the call to cleansing now.
