Denying Christ

- I. *The Awful Sin*
 - A. The disciple who made beautiful confessions concerning Jesus Christ denied his friendship and discipleship with Jesus. He denied knowing Him.
 - B. Let us humbly see our sin in Peter's sin - with Peter we have failed to live out of our identity in Jesus Christ.
- II. *The Saving Look*
 - A. Immediately after Peter denied Jesus the third time, the rooster crowed and Peter saw Jesus. What is the significance of this look?
 - B. This look of Jesus was powerful to bring Peter to a true repentance for his sins.
- III. *The Added Suffering*
 - A. There was no man who could suffer what Christ suffered.
 - B. But this shows us also that only Jesus could suffer for our sins.
