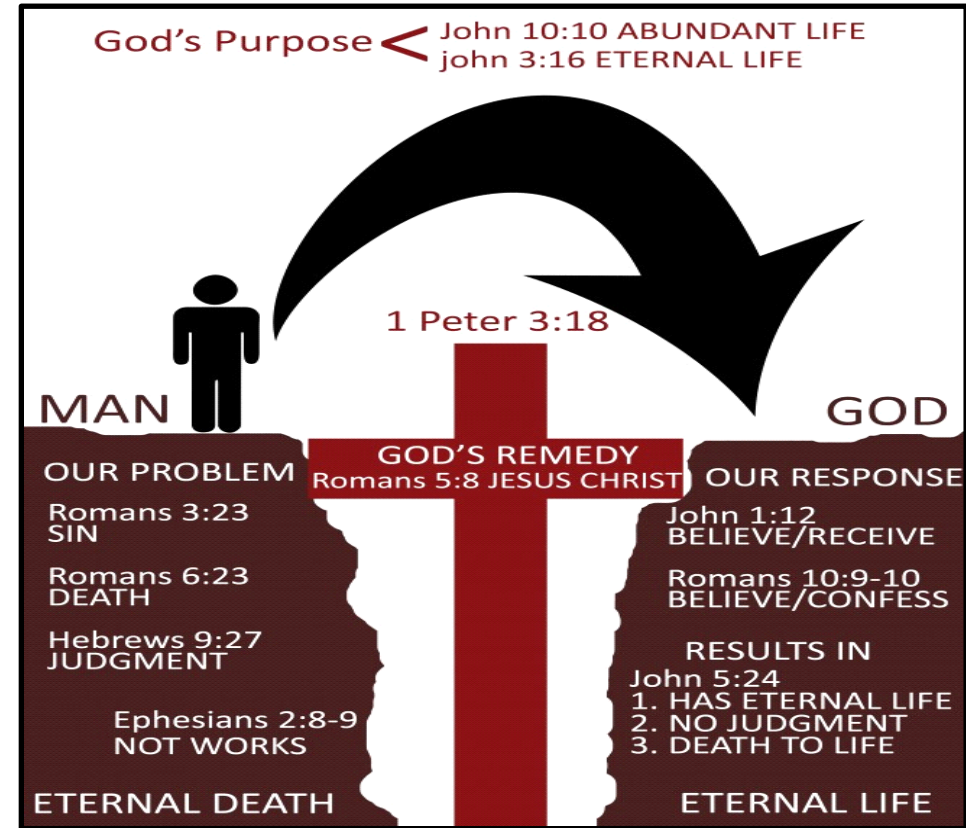

Proclaiming the Lord's Death
1 Corinthians 11:23–26

We proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ when we share the Lord's Supper.
The Lord's Supper is an object lesson for the gospel.

How is the gospel proclaimed at the Lord's Supper?

Remembering the Lord's death in the past.

- His broken body was given for us - **Hebrews 10:5–10; 1 Peter 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree; 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**
- His blood was shed for us - **Hebrews 9:12; 10:16–17; Mark 14:24 And He said to them, "This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many; 1 Corinthians 5:7 For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.**

Considering the Lord's resurrection in the present.

- Jesus Christ is alive and because He lives, we live - **John 14:19 A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live also.**
- Eating the Lord's Supper is a testimony to eternal life in Christ - **Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.**

Anticipating the Lord's return in the future.

- Jesus anticipated the future time of sharing the Passover meal with Israel in the Millennial Kingdom (Eze 45:21) - **Luke 22:14–17**
- Jesus also anticipated His return to receive His bride, the church, into His kingdom at the marriage supper of the Lamb - **Luke 22:18–20; John 14:1–3 Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also; Revelation 19:9 Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."**

The Lord's Supper is only to be eaten in a worthy manner - **1 Corinthians 11:27–34**

- You must understand the meaning of the Lord's Supper.
- You must believe the Lord Jesus Christ.
- You must be in right fellowship with Christ and His people.

Our prayer is that Village Bible Church will proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the Lord's Supper till He comes!
