Matthew 7:7 (KJV)

⁷ Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Matthew 7:7 (TEV)

7 "Ask, and you will receive; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you.

Matthew 7:7 (NIV)

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

Matthew 7:8 (KJV)

8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Matthew 7:8 (TEV)

8 For everyone who asks will receive, and anyone who seeks will find, and the door will be opened to those who knock.

Matthew 7:8 (NIV)

Matthew 7:11 (TEV)

As bad as you are, you know how to give good things to your children. How much more, then, will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

Matthew 7:11 (NIV)

If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him! The Important Gifts of the Father
