Lesson 32, Revelation 2:18-23

KJV, And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath His eyes like unto a flame of fire, and His feet are like fine brass; ¹⁹I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. ²⁰Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce My servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. ²¹And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. ²²Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. ²³And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am He which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

I. OBSERVATIONS FROM TODAY'S PARTICULARS

- **v18** Jesus address the evangelist of Thyatira, expressing His deity (*Son of God*), & He who reveals Himself as the eternal Sacrifice (*eyes like a flame of fire*), as well as our great High Priest (*feet like burnished bronze*).
- **v19** Jesus is intimately aware of six areas wherein the saints at Thyatira have excelled, & also at the time of the writing of this letter, greater in quality & more abundant in quantity.
- **vv20-21** Jesus rebukes the church for permitting Jezebelian teaching to seduce believers into gross sin, which had been going on for a long time because the Lord Jesus had given the leaders of the sect ample time to reflect & repent.
- **vv22-23** The repercussions for unrepentance is a sickly, languishing fellowship (*sickbed*), tribulation for those dabbling in her doctrines & deeds (*adulterers*), & death for the cults disciples (*children*).
