**We Profess Our Faith**  
*Westminster Shorter Catechism 23-26*

**Q. 23 What offices doth Christ execute as our Redeemer?**

**A. Christ, as our Redeemer, executeth the offices of a prophet, of a priest, and of a king, both in His estate of humiliation and exaltation.**

**Q. 24 How doth Christ execute the office of a prophet?**

**A. Christ executeth the office of a prophet in revealing to us, by His word and Spirit, the will of God for our salvation.**

Q. 25 How doth Christ execute the office of a priest?

**A. Christ executeth the office of a priest, in His once offering up of Himself a sacrifice to satisfy divine justice, and reconcile us to God and in making continual intercession for us.**

Q. 26 How doth Christ execute the office of a king?

**A. Christ executeth the office of a king, in subduing us to Himself, in ruling and defending us, and in restraining and conquering all His and our enemies.**
