

MARK 15:33-39
“THE CURTAIN WAS TORN”

I. Christ’s death is cosmic.

- A. Miraculous darkness (Ex. 10:21-22; Josh. 10:12-14)
- B. Cursed darkness (Ex. 10:23; Dt. 28:27-29; Is. 8:21-22)
- C. Darkness ended (Gn. 1:3; Is. 9:1-2; Ps. 36:9; Rv. 21:23)

II. Christ’s death is a substitute.

- A. “Why have you forsaken me?” (Ps. 22:1)
- B. The wages of sin (Gn. 2:16-17; Ro. 5:12)
- C. A sacrifice for sinners (Ro. 5:15-21; Heb. 10:1-18)

III. Christ’s death reveals what is hidden.

- A. Revealing sin (Zech. 12:10-14; Mt. 27:3-4; Lk. 23:39-41; Acts 2:23, 36-37)
- B. Revealing God’s love (Jn. 3:16; 1 Jn. 3:16; 4:7-10)
- C. Revealing God’s power in Christ (Heb. 7:16; Col. 1:15-20)
- D. Revealing God’s salvation to the nations (Is. 49:6; Mk. 1:11; 15:39; Eph. 2:11-22)
