Theme: God will accomplish all his holy purposes. Our plans must conform to His plans if we want to see His purposes fulfilled in us and through us.

Intro/background - "A man a plan a canal Panama." Ever had to change your plans?

## I. A Good Plan

- A. Paul and Silas "visit" the churches then look to south west. They make a loop down to the churches along the Mediterranean via Ephesus?
- B. Their way is blocked
  - 1. Not to the SW the Holy Spirit kept them from preaching there. v.6
  - 2. Not to the North the "Spirit of Jesus" wouldn't allow them. v.7
  - 3. Only one door open move toward the northwest.
- C. Holy Spirit At Work (Need a big sign!)
  - NOTE: Spirit of Jesus/Holy Spirit/Spirit of God? Are one and the same. Holy Spirit is a distinct person in the trinity (Col.1:27; Eph.4:30; 1 Cor.12:3)
    - 1. The Holy Spirit closes doors!
      - a. Took the open path to keep moving ahead.
      - b. Your response
        - Lord, where to now? OR
        - I quit.
    - 2. Holy Spirit was leading *clearly*.
      - By restraining them He turns them to Troas
      - Could have gone down to Ephesus and sailed from there.
      - God had other plans.

## II. A Bigger Plan

- A. The Gospel goes to Europe
  - Paul and Silas know that? No.
  - Holy Spirit know that? YES!
- B. The Spirit gives an open door!
  - a. Doors closed before
  - b. Now? Please come!
  - c. Taking counsel
    - "concluded" i.e. "they came to one mind"

- C. God's Leading is Clear!
  - Go to Macedonia.
  - ASIDE: On God's Guidance
    - 1. Paul often led directly by God. Acts 9:4; 13:2; 21:11
    - 2. We are not led in similar fashion.
      - We have the Revelation of God in Jesus Christ.
      - Private revelations are more to be feared than sought.
      - But God does *illumine* His word. God does reveal His plans and purposes.
    - 3. These same patterns are appropriate for us.
      - 1. To know His way, know His Word.
      - 2. God will *illumine* His Word to guide you.
      - 3. Act! In faith, in trust, in peace
- D. GOD IS SOVEREIGN!!
- E. God's Bigger Plan??
  - 1. Paul and Silas would have gone right to Ephesus.
    - God *delayed* it. He did not *deny* it!
  - 2. God's plan? Establish the beachhead!

## **III.** The Best Plan – Salvation!

- A. On the Sabbath Day -v.13
- B. God's Plan Unfolds
  - Preach the good news
  - The Lord Opens the hearts of those he calls
  - The Word bears fruit in her life.

## **IV. Rest in His Plans**

- Do you trust God to lead you?
- Are you engaged in His service so that he can lead you?
- Have you heard and received this life changing news? God gives eternal life to those who repent of their sins and look to Jesus for forgiveness and eternal life?
