

WHAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT THE CHRIST?

Matthew 22:41-46

41 Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question, 42 saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" They said to him, "The son of David". 43 He said to them, "How is it then that David, in the Spirit, calls him Lord, saying, 44 "'The Lord said to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet."'"? 45 If then David calls him Lord, how is he his son?" 46 And no one was able to answer him a word, nor from that day did anyone dared to ask him any more questions.

This question: "What do you think about the Christ, whose Son is He?" must be personally considered by all who hear the gospel call or claim Him as their Christ.

3. As Son of God, Jesus Christ Reigns and All His Enemies Will Be Subdued Under His Feet.

Psalm 110, Psalm 45:5

Why will Jesus' enemies be subdued under His feet?

4. Human Pride and the Fear of Man Keep Many People from Being Reconciled to God.

Isaiah 2:22, John 12:43, 1 Corinthians 11:31

In what ways does pride or the fear of what others will think keep you from being reconciled with God and/or others?


